1. Introduction

- **Performance / Analytics Cookies** – to analyze website usage, understand how visitors interact with our pages, and improve our services.
- **Functionality / Personalization Cookies** – to remember your preferences, such as language or login details, and provide a more customized experience.
- **Targeting / Advertising Cookies** – to show relevant content or advertisements based on your interests

4. First-Party and Third-Party Cookies

- **First-party cookies** are set by our website.
- **Third-party cookies** are set by external services we use (e.g., Google Analytics, social media platforms). We do not control how these third parties use cookies; please refer to their privacy policies for more information.
